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MODULE 7 | Environmental Sustainability

Introduction and Instructions How to Use this Tool

You are going to start implementing your own environmentally sustainable approaches. The below questions will help you assess where you are in terms of implementing environmental sustainability in your tourism business.

The below questions should be considered, and answers provided by all staff. Start by considering your internal business, what you purchase, your external environment and landscapes, how you conserve, protect, reuse, and recycle where possible. Sit down with your staff especially those working in areas that you could be potentially negatively impacting the environment or business sustainability e.g., outdoor environment (e.g., landscaping, irrigation, signage), procurement (e.g., cleaning products, food, furniture, electrical appliances) health and safety (e.g., checking electrical appliances, water health), maintenance (e.g., replacing bulbs, plumbing, electrical) suppliers (e.g., food, souvenirs, bed linen, coffee)

When you go through these questions and come up with a set of answers, start prioritizing what needs to happen first, then what can be done in the short term, medium term and long germ. Start working on educating how you will implement the environmental approaches required so that you can as a team move to being more consciously and aware of your environment and business sustainability. Make sure to complement your implementation with an Action Plan inclusive of roles, responsibilities, KPIs, dates, resources, actions, tasks etc...

Step 1 Answer each question honestly with your staff members

Step 2 Tick the check box to indicate what you already do. In the Priorities Box follow this prioritise as follows.

- Priority 1 (needs to happen and can happen now (2-3 weeks)
- Priority 2 (needs to happen but needs time (2-3 months)
- Priority 3 (needs to happen but needs longer to implement (3-6 months)

Step 3 Assign a person responsible, set up an <u>Environmentally Sustainable Action Plan</u>, have regular meetings to monitor, measure and keep moving forward.
